Mrs Slater/Mrs Scullion's Year 4 Children, Swimming Lessons

Swimming for Mrs Slater/Mrs Scullion's class – Year 4 children, begins Friday 7th December. The children will travel by coach to the Geoff Moulder leisure pool each Friday afternoon, **departing at 12:30 and returning at approx. 14:00** (water time 13:00 to 13:30). Children will have their lunch a little earlier on Fridays before they go swimming. Staff will accompany the class to and from the pool. Over the sessions the children have the opportunity to improve their water safety and swimming techniques.

There will be six sessions over terms 2 and 3. The last session will be on Friday 1st February.

There is a voluntary contribution of **£3.00 each week**, this helps to pay for transport by coach, hire of the pool and the services of extra swimming teachers. **You can now pay online via ParentMail.**

Please send your child with their swimming kit in a suitable bag on Fridays. If your child (girl or boy) has long hair *it must be tied back*. Earrings should not be worn, ideally left out on the days your child swims or takes part in any PE (the pool ask that irremovable studs be taped over). Boys swimwear has to be above the knee.
